Final Report - Period 30 September to 7 November 1945

- 1. Herewith statistics covering operations of the 2/5 General Hospital subsequent to 30 September 1945
- 2. 2/5 Gen Hospital ceased to admit patients from 8 October '45, and evacuated all remaining
- © 2/5 Australian General Hospital

- 3. All medical stores and equipment were packed out and returned to 2 Base Depot Medical Stores on 5 November 1945
- 4. Equipment and vehicles required to equip an AGH of 600 beds, allowing for an expansion of 150 beds, has been retained and prepared for transfer to 130 General Hospital on arrival of that Unit in this area.
- 5. All low priority personnel and the lower ranges of high priority personnel have been transferred out to medical and other Units in the area, with the exception of those retained as key personnel, pending the arrival of 130 General Hospital to take over the equipment.
- 6. AAMC Officers (female), AANS and AAMWS have been moved by air to their states of enlistment for re-allotment, or are in process of being moved thereto.
- 7. Disbandment Order (AG1001/169 of 30 Oct '45) of 1 Base Sub Area directs that all action be Completed by 7 November 1945
- 8. Completion of action is dependent on the arrival of 130 General Hospital in area, and until the handover to this Unit is effected, the retention of a small Admin Cadre is necessary.
- 9. It is proposed to embark all remaining members of the unit with baggage, or female personnel, on 2/1 Hospital Ship at an early date.
